

Updated COVID-19 Safety Measures for Live PRI Courses

11/18/21

- Course attendees will be asked to stay home if they have had a fever or any respiratory symptoms within the past 3 days. In this event, the course tuition can be transferred to a home study or future live stream or live course date.
- Tables will be spaced out further from each other to allow for greater social distancing.
- Individuals will be asked to sit in the same seat on day two that they sat in on day one.
- Course attendees will receive individual 2 oz. hand sanitizer bottles provided by PRI for their own use.
- The host site will disinfect all course tables each morning and/or evening.
- Mask policy will depend on the local or state regulations, and/or hosting organization.
 - If there is a mask mandate in place in the state or city where the course is being held, then course attendees will be required to comply and wear a face mask at all times during the course. They will be allowed to go outside on breaks and remove their mask. Course attendees will be encouraged to bring their own face mask; however, the host site will be asked to have disposable masks onsite for anyone who may not bring a mask with them.
 - If there is no local or state mask mandate, then it will be at the discretion of the host site organization to determine if masks are required to be worn at all times. If an individual has not been vaccinated, we kindly ask that they continue to wear their mask throughout the entirety of the course.
 - The instructor, if they have not been vaccinated or if there is a mask mandate in place, will wear a face mask when directly interacting with course attendees (answering questions, walking around during breaks, demonstration or during lab sessions). Instructors will not wear a mask when they are lecturing at the front of the room, however they will attempt to maintain 6 feet distance from the nearest table.
 - Regardless of mask mandate policies at the local or state level, PRI will continue to require that all course attendees continue to wear masks during lab sessions.
- During lab sessions, course attendees will not be required to participate in small break out groups if they are not comfortable doing so.
- PRI will continue refraining from the use of balloons with PRI Non-Manual Techniques during demonstration and lab sessions at this time.
