Sunday, September 15, 2019

Munich

Pre-tour cocktail/hors d'oeuvres reception with your tour manager at the hotel once your PRI coursework is completed.

Day 1 Monday, September 16, 2019 Munich | Český Krumlov Depart from Munich and travel to the Bohemian village of Český Krumlov. It is a living gallery of Renaissance-era buildings, a castle, charming cafes, restaurants, shops, and galleries. Overnight stay with dinner included.

Day 2 Tuesday, September 17, 2019 Český Krumlov | Prague Morning departure for Prague. Sightseeing of the Old Town today with a guided walking tour. See the Jan Hus Square, Tyne Church, Astronomical Clock, Estates Theatre and the Charles Bridge. The evening is at leisure.

Day 3 Wednesday, September 18, 2019 Prague
Sightseeing of Prague continues today with a trip to the Prague
Castle situated high above the city. See the Gothic St. Vitus
Cathedral and the nearby Golden Lanes. Enjoy an evening
dinner cruise on the Vltava (Moldau River).

Saturday, September 14, 2019

Option: Guided City-Tour of Munich (4-5 hours)—\$80 pp
Get to know Munich as you begin at the Marienplatz, the heart
of Munich with the magnificent city hall and the famous
glockenspiel. After that you can wander through
the Viktualienmarkt market square with its traditional food
stalls and drive along the elegant Maximilianstrasse with its
exclusive shops.

Continue along the most beautiful areas in the city through the quarter of Schwabing with its colourful shops, cafes and ateliers, and enjoy a view of the Olympia Park with its unique architecture. Afterwards, take a short detour to Nymphenburg Palace, the baroque summer residence of the Bavarian kings, with its splendid, extensive gardens.

Option: Excursion to Herrenchiemsee (6-hours)—\$100 pp In 1873 King Ludwig II of Bavaria acquired the Herreninsel as the location for his Royal Palace of Herrenchiemsee (New Palace). Modeled on Versailles, this palace was built as a "Temple of Fame" for King Louis XIV of France, whom the Bavarian monarch fervently admired. The excursion will include transportation and a tour of the palace.
